

# EXPERIENCE

SPEAKERS' NOTES for Continuous Leo Development Education programme.

*(The following notes will assist CLD Speaker to deliver at Leo club meetings. It is recommended that the speaker go into details on the notes so that the Leos will understand better. The notes are set in question and answer manner so that you can be elaborated thoroughly. The speaker may touch on three questions and answers at each Leo Club Meeting or at his/her own discretion).*

Experience: (Oxford) The knowledge and skill that you have gained through doing something for a period of time.

Experience in a service organization means taking part in activities.

## What are the types of activities/projects for Leos?

Public Service: e.g. proper use of public utilities or care for the aged and poor or involve in Rukun Tetangga,

Health Service: e.g. Health screening, anti drug abuse, autism, handicapped children.

Community Service: e.g. cleanliness campaign, visit to old folks home, collecting old clothes or newspapers and distribution of tinned food.

Education Service: e.g. painting the school, financial assistance, skill development, or youth camps.

Sight Conservation: e.g. cataract operation, help the blind, eye test, giving free spectacles.

Environmental Service: e.g. collecting pollutants, beautification projects, recycle used products.

Projects must reflect participation, prudence and publicity

## What are the steps to organize an activity/project?

It involves: (1) Publicity (2) Discussion on the objective (3) Planning (4) Logistics (5) Costing (6) Participation/ involvement of members.

## What is participation in Activities/ projects?

- Planning and publicity of the project: target group, cost, manpower, publicity.
- Reporting the project: Leo Club Advisor (Sponsoring Lions Club). Faculty Advisor ( School), DC Leo Clubs (District)
- Auditing of accounts.

## What are the uses of experience?

An experienced Leo will be able to demonstrate the best direction to take in life.

Through experience, the Leos will be able to:

- (1) Gain from the results of what has been done (make reports)
- (2) Improve on what has been done
- (3) Add on possible areas for further extension, e.g.: channel results to other projects
- (4) Gain skills and knowledge
